



Junior Environmental Technician

Cardinal Energy has a full time, seasonal opportunity for a Junior Environmental Technician, working to assess roadway watercourse crossings, conduct site inspections on oil and gas facilities, execute basic sampling and report to the Environmental Coordinator. The duration of employment is expected to be from May 2019 to September 2019 with the possibility for extension for the right candidate. The position will be based out of Cardinal's Slave Lake field office for the duration of employment, with potential occasional travel to the main office in Calgary.

Key responsibilities:

- Assessing roadway watercourse crossings for compliance with the Government of Alberta's Roadway Watercourse Crossing Directive
- Assist in reviewing oil and gas production locations for reclamation/remediation/no entry status
- Data entry into Cardinal's web based tracking system
- Liaise with Operations, Land and other disciplines as required
